TOUR OF MANGOCHI & SURROUNDING AREA

This is a half-day tour by car taking you to the fishing village, and the nearby town of Mangochi. Mangochi harbours some important history for the nation and the Yao people residents in this region dating back to the pre-colonial era. The name Mangochi was derived from a nearby mountain. Some Yao chiefs explain that the name Mangochi means Mgoji, a rope, and signifies the place where Yao immigrants were bound together in a strong community. In October 1891, the colonial government established a fort known as Fort Johnston in the Mangochi area to protect British interests. Following this establishment Mangochi became a very significant place and was then popularly known as the Fort Johnston District. It was however changed back to Mangochi some years later after independence.
